The Czech Ministry of Culture has supported the Film New Europe project with a grant of between 8000 and 11 000 EUR annually for the past five years via a grant to the Film New Europe Association. A grant of more than 11 000 EUR has already been agreed for 2017 for the FNE project.

This involves a grant application process each year and the Czech Ministry cannot give any letter of intent about the outcome of this grant application process in advance.

But based on the past history and ongoing satisfaction of the Czech Ministry with the results of the editions from 2010-2016 the FNE Association feels confident that the Czech Ministry will continue to support FNE at the same level in 2017-2018.

The Cyprus Ministry of Education and Culture has also supported FNE through the FNE Association for the past few years with the sum of 500 EUR annually. FNE is the only such international project that Cyprus supports because of the realisation of the focus on the specificity of small countries in FNE.

Provided that such support is received from the Czech Ministry of Culture the FNE Association will support the Film New Europe project with a similar sum as in previous years.

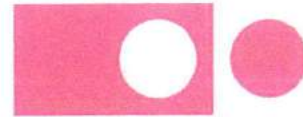
